
■ The World of Dreams – Activity Pack

SET 1 – KINDER / 4–5 YEARS OLD

Theme: Dreams and Imagination

1. Listen and Imagine

Play the song or poem 'The World of Dreams'. Ask children to imagine what they see, what colours appear, and who might live in that world. Encourage them to share their ideas after listening.

2. Draw Your Dream Box

Children draw and decorate their magical dream box filled with treasures. Label the drawing with simple words (toy, rainbow, cat, star, cake). Optional: make real 'dream boxes' with recycled materials.

3. Dramatize the Dream

Invite children to act out scenes from the poem: sailing a pirate ship, exploring a giant's cave, walking through a glowing garden. Use scarves, ribbons, or paper props.

4. Let's Talk

Discuss questions like: What was your favourite part of the dream? Who would you meet there? Would you like to live there or just visit?

5. Bedtime Wishes Craft

Children create a dream wand with paper stars and ribbons. Write 'May all your dreams come true!' and recite the poem's final stanza together.



SET 2 – PRIMARY / 6–8 YEARS OLD

Theme: Creating and Exploring My World of Dreams

1. Comprehension & Reflection

Discuss what makes the world of dreams magical and why dreams matter. Ask inference questions: Have you ever had a dream that felt real?

2. Creative Writing: 'My Dream Adventure'

Children write a short story or poem about their dream, with a beginning, middle, and ending. They can add illustrations or small comics.

3. Vocabulary & Grammar Fun

Identify nouns (box, ship, cave, garden, dream) and adjectives (mighty, glowing, magical, shining, hidden). Combine them to invent new dream phrases like 'magical box' or 'shining cave'.

4. Perform Your Dream

In small groups, children dramatize a stanza or create a tableau (frozen picture) with simple props. Helps rhythm and confidence.

5. STEAM Extension – Dreamworld Diorama

Create a 3D 'World of Dreams' in a shoebox using cotton, paper, and small lights. Label the objects and describe them in English.

Cross-Curricular Ideas

- Science: Why do we dream?
- Art: Paint or collage a night sky with glowing colours.
- Music: Compose a lullaby or rhythm for the poem.
