As dawn starts to break.

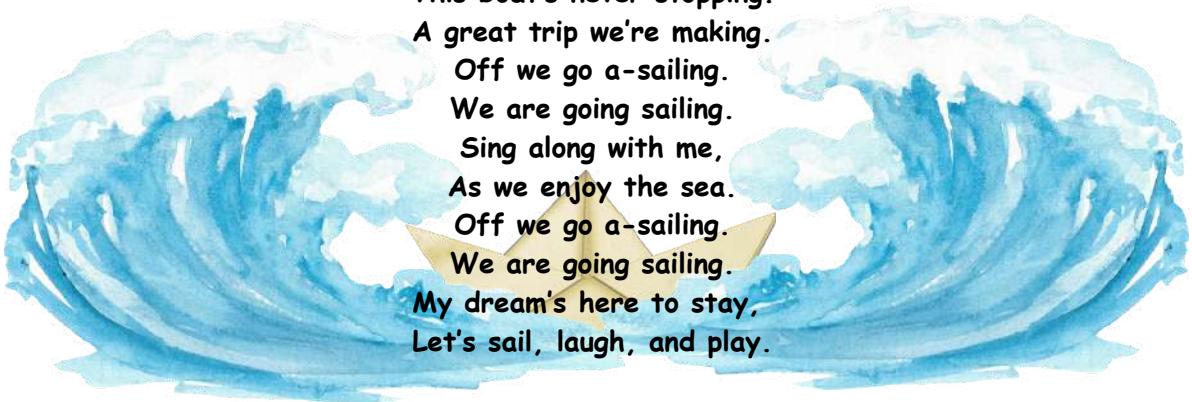


Off we go a-sailing.

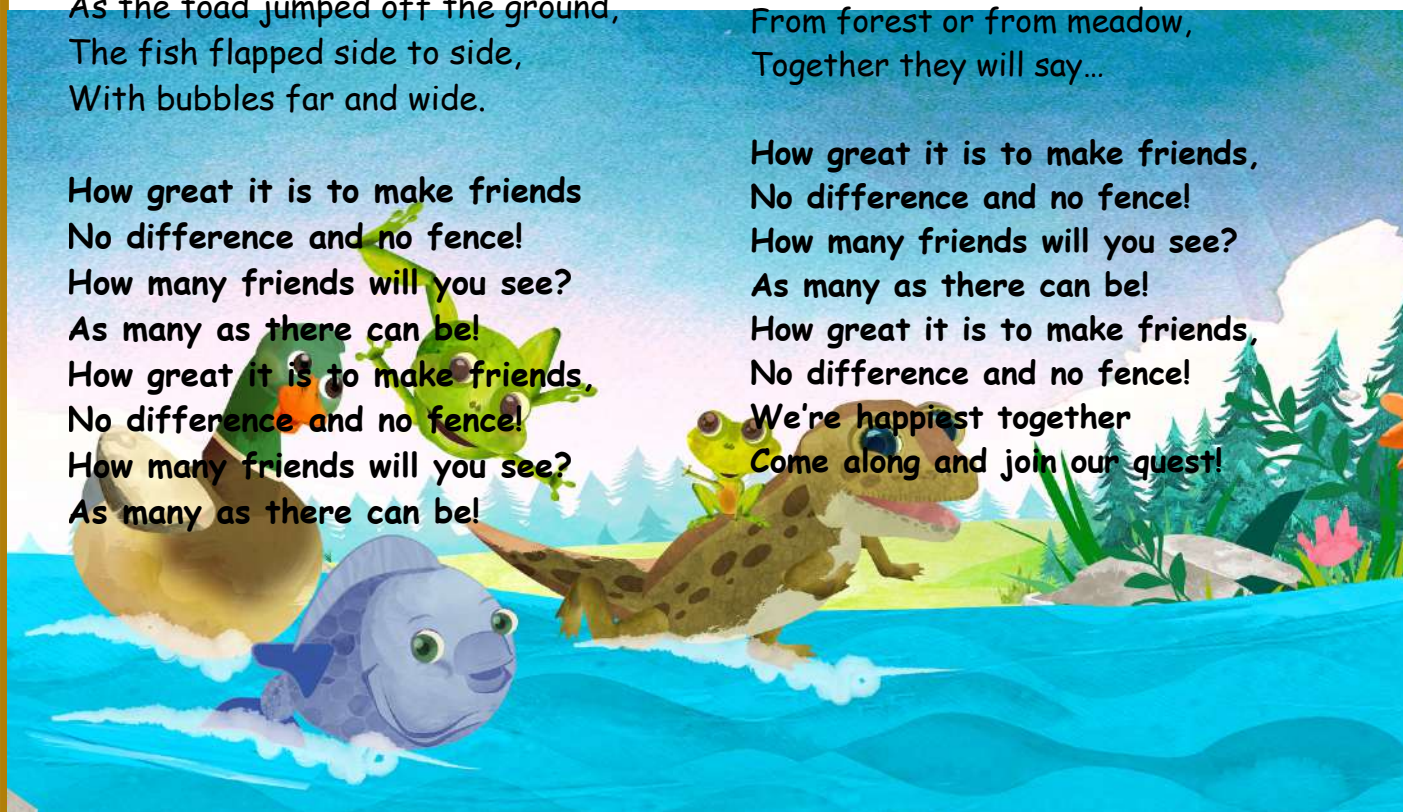
While playing hide and seek,
